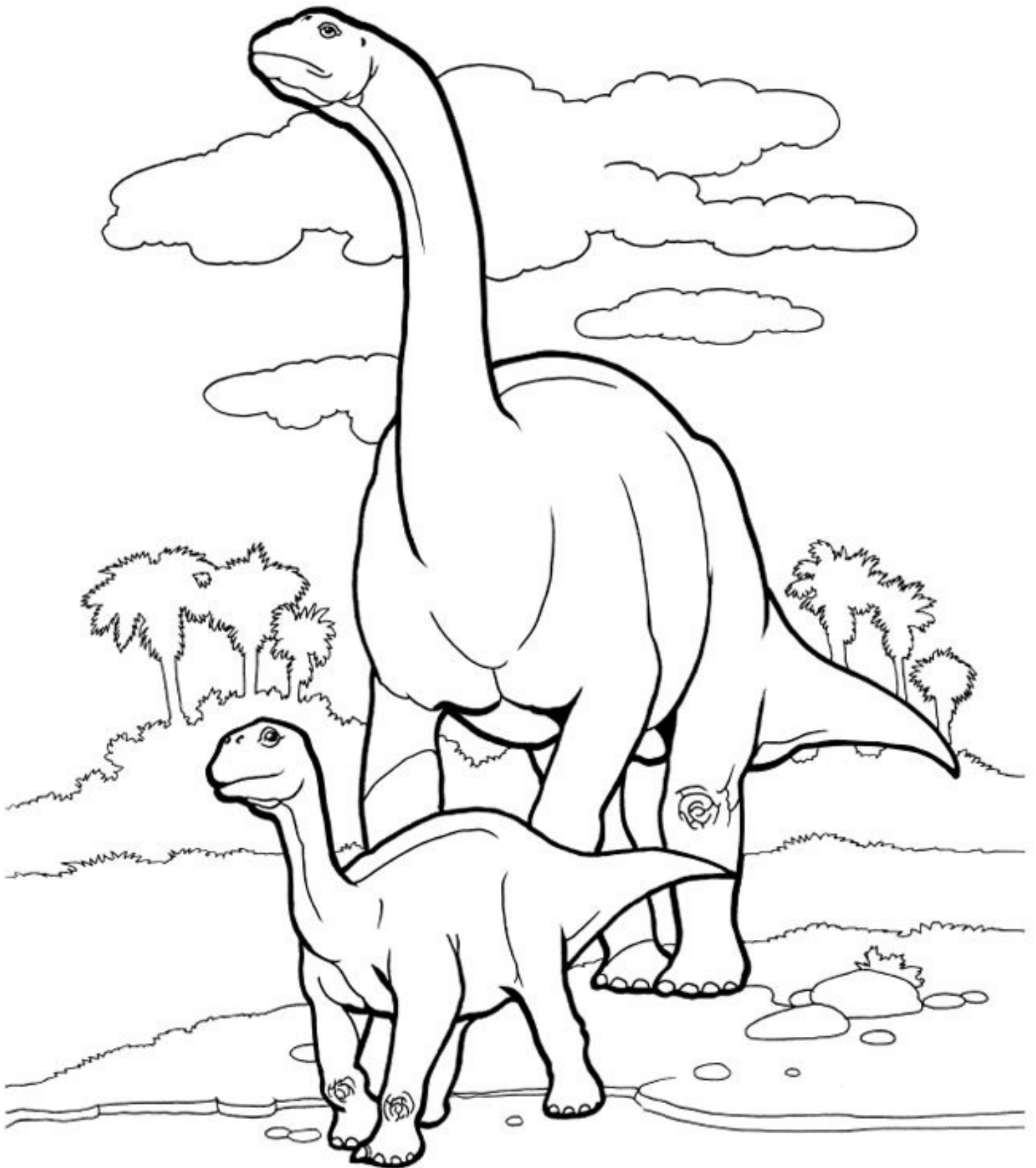




The name **Camarasaurus** means "chambered lizard," referring to the holes in its vertebrae. They could be found in parts of North America and Portugal. These nineteen-ton plant eaters

had strong jaws and chisel teeth. They were one of the most common Jurassic dinosaurs and measured fifty-nine-feet long and fifteen-feet high at the hips.
